

1) Federal abortion policy

Do you support overturning the U.S. Supreme Court's 1973 ruling in Roe v. Wade, which asserted the existence of a federal constitutional right to abortion?

2) Freedom of Choice Act (FOCA)

Will you vote to oppose the Freedom of Choice Act, which proposes to codify a right to abortion in federal law, thereby nullifying state laws that seek to protect unborn human life?

3) Embryonic stem cell research

Do you support a ban on federal funding for stem cell research that involves the destruction of human embryos?

4) Funding of groups involved in abortion

Do you support a ban on any federal funding of groups that perform or promote abortions, such as Planned Parenthood?

5) Mexico City Policy

Do you support restoring the Mexico City Policy, the policy repealed by President Obama, that formerly prohibited federal funding of international groups that perform or promote abortion as a method of family planning?

6) Human cloning

Do you support legislation to ban the cloning of human embryos?

7) Defense of Marriage Act

Will you oppose efforts to repeal the federal Defense of Marriage Act (DOMA), which defines marriage as being a union of one man and one woman for purposes of federal law, and provides that states do not have to recognize same-sex marriages from other states?

8) Federal marriage amendment

Do you support an amendment to the U.S. Constitution that would affirm the definition of marriage as being a union of one man and one woman?

9) Employment Non-Discrimination Act (ENDA)


